Mobile Phones are not to be Heard, are not to be Used, and are not to be Seen.

First Offense: confiscation of the cell phone for one month

Second Offense: confiscation of the cell phone until the last day of school

<u>Third Offense:</u> confiscation of any new cell phone until the last day of school
